# Multi-Use Tester-III Scan Tool System Installation Guide

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## Welcome to the Multi-Use Tester-III Scan Tool System

The Multi-Use Tester-III (MUT-III) Scan Tool System is used by service technicians to diagnose and repair Sterling 360 light duty vehicles. MUT-III reads the information broadcasted by the ECUs on the vehicle's databus and relays the information through a cable connection to your laptop or desktop computer.

You can use MUT-III to retrieve failure codes, monitor engine, transmission and ABS data, and launch troubleshooting procedures for fault codes.

**NOTE** A service manual is NOT included with Sterling MUT-III even though it appears as an option on the main menu of the program.

#### **System Requirements**

MUT-III requires the following hardware and software to run.

- Laptop or desktop computer running Windows 2000 or Windows XP (Service Pack 1)
- CD-ROM drive

**CAUTION** Windows XP (Service Pack 2) is not recommended. If your computer is running Windows XP (Service Pack 2), see "Windows XP (Service Pack 2)" on page 11.

### **Before You Begin**

To ensure a successful installation, review the following checklist.

- Make sure that your computer meets MUT-III hardware and software requirements. See "System Requirements" on page 3.
- Close all open programs before starting the installation process.
- Disable any anti-virus, firewall, spyware, or pop-up blocker software.
- Contact your system administrator if you do not have administrative rights to install software on your computer.

**CAUTION** Do not change your computer's Full Computer Name after you install the MUT-III software.

## **Multi-Use Tester III Scan Tool System Installation**

This documentation reflects the installation of MUT-III on a Windows 2000 operating system. Depending on your computer's operating system, installation instructions and screen shots may differ.

To install MUT-III:

1. Insert the MUT-III CD into the CD-ROM drive.

**NOTE** If the installation does not start after you insert the CD, Click **Start** | **Run**. Then type E: \Mut3Check.exe (replace E:\ with the actual CD-ROM drive letter). Click **OK**.

2. Click **Yes** to begin the installation.

4. If a warning message appears that states that a setup right access went wrong, complete the following steps. Do not click OK on the warning message dialog box. Complete the following steps first.



- A. Right-click **Start** | **Explore**. Windows Explorer opens.
- B. On the C:\ drive, click **Program Files** to open the folder.

C. Right-click the **MUT3\_TB** folder, and then click **Properties**. The MUT3\_TB Properties dialog box appears.

- **D.** Click the **Security** tab.
- E. Under Name, select Users.
- F. Under Permissions, select Allow next to Full Control.
- G. Click OK.
- H. Click 🗵 to close Windows Explorer.
- I. Return to the MUT-III installation.

5. On the Warning dialog box, click **OK**.

The MUT-III Diagnostic S/W for TRUCK&BUS install appears.

6. Click Next.

A status bar tracks the installation progress.

7. Click Finish.

Be patient as message and image files are copied to the computer. This may take several minutes.

8. Click **MUT-III Installation** on the **Service manual data installation** dialog box to install the interactive diagnosis viewer data.

**9.** Click **Yes** on the **Service manual data installation** dialog box to install the diagnostics data.

- Click **OK** to complete the installation.

- 11. Remove the MUT-III CD from the CD-ROM drive.
- 12. Click **OK** to restart the computer and start using MUT-III.



13. On the computer Desktop, double-click the **MUT-III** icon to start the program.

**NOTE** If you are running Windows XP SP2 and MUT-III does not start when you double-click the icon on the computer Desktop, see "Windows XP (Service Pack 2)" on page 11.

#### **Vehicle Communication Interface Installation**

A USB cable is provided to connect your computer to a vehicle.



To install the Vehicle Communication Interface (VCI):

- 1. Plug one end of the provided USB cable into the VCI unit.
- 2. Plug one end of the provided USB cable into the computer's USB port.

3. Turn on the computer if it is not already on.



Windows detects the USB device and starts the Found New Hardware Wizard.

- 4. Click Next.
- 5. Select Search for a suitable driver for my device, and then click Next.

8. On the Driver Files Search Results dialog box, click Next. Windows locates and installs the VCI driver.

If you receive the message that the Vehicle Communication Interface has not passed Windows Logo testing, click Continue Anyway.

9. Click Finish to complete the VCI installation.

## **Uninstall MUT-III**

You must perform the uninstall steps in the following order.

To uninstall MUT-III:

1. Log on to your computer.



 $\overline{\gamma}$  **NOTE** If you do not have administrative rights, contact your system administrator to uninstall MUT-III.

- 2. Click Start | Settings | Control Panel.
- 3. Double-click Add/Remove Programs.
- 4. Click MUT-III Diagnostic S/W for TRUCK&BUS.

The Change/Remove dialog box appears.

5. Click Change/Remove.



Windows removes MUT-III Diagnostic S/W for TRUCK&BUX.

6. Click MUT-III System for TRUCK&BUS.

The Change/Remove dialog box appears.

7. Click Change/Remove.



Windows removes MUT-III System for TRUCK&BUS.

#### **User Guide**

You can find the MUT-III user guide on the main menu of the program. To locate the MUT-III user guide:

- 1. Start MUT-III.
- 2. On the main menu, click MUT-III Manual.

## Windows XP (Service Pack 2)

If you do not know if your computer is running Windows XP (Service Pack 2), contact your system administrator.

**CAUTION** Changes to the Windows XP SP2 security settings can pose a security risk. It is recommended that you do not browse public Internet sites when you use MUT-III on a system running Windows XP SP2 due to virus vulnerability.

Make the following changes to start MUT-III on a computer running Windows XP (Service Pack 2):

- 1. Start Internet Explorer.
- 2. On the **Tools** menu, click **Internet Options**. The Internet Options dialog box appears.
- **3.** Click the **Advanced** tab.
- 4. Select Allow active content from CDs to run on My Computer.
- 5. Select Allow active content to run in files on My Computer.
- 6. Click OK to close the Internet Options dialog box.
- 7. Close Internet Explorer.
